Location:	Located near the Karlsplatz/Stachus in the heart of Munich, the Excelsior by Geisel is just a 15-minute walk away from the world-famous Marienplatz. Moreover, Munich's most popular sights and museums as well as the airport (40 minutes) and the exhibition area (20 minutes) can be easily accessed, due to the close connection to the central station (150 m), underground and tram.
Operator:	Carl, Michael and Stephan Geisel as shareholder of Cosmopolitan Hotelbetriebs GmbH – part of Geisel Privathotels: Exclusive Munich hotel group, founded in 1900, owned by the fourth generation of the Geisel family. The portfolio includes the city residence BEYOND, the First-Class-Hotel Excelsior with the popular restaurant Vinothek and the hybrid hotel Schwabinger Wahrheit. A vineyard and the exclusive wine shop Geisels Weingalerie.

Opening:	During World War II, the hotel, which has been in possession of the Geisel family since 1936, was used as headquarter for the occupying powers until its reopening in 1956. In 1986, the hotel was completely renovated, implementing a groundbreaking architecture and design. Expansion of the hotel in 2012, modernization of the conference rooms in 2014. And the renovations continue. In 2017, the guest rooms were renewed and the lobby as well as the facade of the ancient building were re-designed. The expansion of the restaurant Vinothek by Geisel was just completed.
Concept:	Compared to the other Geisel hotels, the Excelsior is the richest in tradition. Influenced by old Bavarian residences, the four-star-hotel uses wood paneling in the restaurant and wall paintings in the lobby. For an authentic experience, the staff is dressed in original local costumes.
Rooms & Suites:	There are 114 classy but cozy rooms at the Excelsior. The 76 double rooms, 26 single rooms and 12 suites stand out with a bright color scheme, decent elegance, and lightness. Especially recommendable are the alpine rooms with their lean, urban interior design. The bathroom combines natural stones from the Dolomites with glass walls working with wooden elements. On top of that, there is a TV integrated in the mirror. The basic equipment includes free WiFi, a flat screen with Sat- and Sky-TV and, in almost all the rooms, an air conditioner. The alpine rooms also

offer an iPod docking station, and the suites contain a Nespresso machine.

Restaurant:

More than 800 of the world's finest wines are on offer at the Vinothek by Geisel restaurant. Host Ferdinand Schuster and chef Benedikt Arps focus on traditional cuisine using regional and seasonal produce. Cooking classes are also offered in the show kitchen. Opening hours are Monday to Friday from 12:00 to 10:00 and Saturday from 4:00 to 10:00. The Vinothek by Geisel is closed on Sundays and public holidays.

Conferences & Events:

Five elegant, partially combinable meeting rooms (35 to 112 m²) and the latest technologies, enable the Excelsior to host events with up to 100 people. Also, the Vinothek can be rented exclusively.

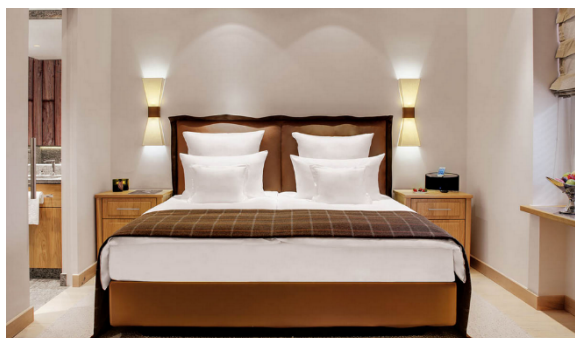
